Greetings!

We are thrilled that you and your parish have been exploring missional opportunities and have come up with an initiative to broaden your parish's missional reach. Those of us who serve on the Diocese of Calgary's Mission Funding Board would love to hear of your proposal as we seek to discern which projects God is calling the Anglican Diocese of Calgary to further support. Because we have limited resources, we won't be able to financially support all funding proposals; however, even if funding may not be available, we might be able to support in other ways (such as the sharing of resources available through our Diocesan Missional Coaches). Priority will be given to churches that have not received other financial support from the diocese in the past year and churches that have not received Mission Funding Board Grants in the past two years. The funds that are available are not to help prop up a church's budget because the parish has experienced a shortfall in giving nor to fund existing ministries of the church, but rather, they are available for new mission initiatives.

At this point it might be helpful to elaborate on what we mean by mission. We believe that mission initiatives are those that seek to reach out to others to share God's love in meaningful ways so that people outside of the church community might be drawn to a closer relationship with God. While our understanding of mission is fairly broad, it is not so broad that it includes "buying mops so that we can make our church look cleaner to those who may come to our church" but instead, initiatives that are directed towards those who are beyond the walls of our church. As Archbishop William Temple once said, "The Church is the only society in the world which exists for the benefit of those who are not its members." Help us on the Mission Funding Board to understand how your initiative will do that. Two guiding pieces of scripture that the Mission Funding Board have found helpful, both come from the Gospel of Matthew. In Matthew 28, just prior to his ascension, Jesus commands his disciples to go and make disciples of all nations and in Matthew 25 Jesus talks about reaching out in practical ways to those on the margins as an expression of reaching out to Jesus. We would like to hear how your initiative might live out those commands of Jesus.
